Alan Melrose from Cairngorms Outdoor Access Trust (COAT)

He is responsible for Delivery of Health Walks through a 2 year project for 100's of paths. Was with UDAT – Upper Deeside Access Trust who were very successful. Project involves daytime access to get out and about, and it fits with the NHS Scotland strategy. Also ties in well with Step It Up Highland, with John Burns. Project is to build the principle of setting up Health related groups with volunteers to take people out and about, using the linked community path networks. Looking to use Carr-bridge and Laggan as pilots. Alan is looking for a commitment for a Group to be formed here to deliver these health projects. Promoting Health Walks and Access is part of Community Planning Partnership strategy
CCC to identify volunteers for this group and Alan will meet with them if we find them. There is also a possibility of assisting with a booklet on Carr-bridge Walks

Concerns of Residents and Any Other Business

Camping in Car Park There is concerned about the issue of hygiene as people have stayed there since start of school holidays. There are notices up preventing longer stays, but PC pointed out that these notices cannot be enforced so it is difficult for HC and Police. SBlack will keep an eye on it
Speeding on Grantown Road Police have been on Inverness Road but not Grantown. KA to email PC Carroll about it
Footpath to Lochanhully Narrow beyond 30 mph sign. SBlack thought that HC are probably only responsible for path to this sign. Alan Melrose to take it back to COAT
Digital Switchover and Car Radios Will there be a problem with reception for digital signal? **SBlack** to take this to TEC Services and Trading Standards
