Overhanging branches near Aviemore cemetery **SBlack**

30mph sign Lying on side of the road at Dalrachney **SBlack**

Station Road No attention paid to gritting/salting – concerns as this is the access to the village from passengers arriving at Carr-bridge station **SBlack**

Drain cover: Outside Primary school drain cover has been moved during snow clearance **SBlack**

### Matters Arising

Cawdor (Tom na Clach) Windfarm : Meeting re Wind Farm is not being heard on 26/02/10 – date to be advised

Play items at playpark. Toddlers Group have quotes for equipment of about £1,600. They have £1,000, but want to ‘match their funding. Advised to give us a Funding Form with details (**KA** to email form) Awaiting return of form.

Planning permission Concerns over planning permission - Stuart Black advised that a completed building certificate would be required .

Ellanwood Road - Some residents would like all trees removed, S Black reported that this has been referred to HC Housing department **Sblack**

Trains : Concerns that the ‘HELP BOX ‘ only gave ‘Emergency Services Only’ and not details on trains due to arrive. Write to Scotrail to ask them why. Also train announcement incorrect as train arrived into different platform. **K Adamson**

Snow clearing: S Black advised that the Council had had a debrief with regard to the snow and that there are approx 12 items to be reviewed . There will be an extra Ward Forum meeting in May to discuss snow clearing on roads only – date to be advised.

Cemetery Entrance ) SBlack has reported this will be looked at in springtime

Path to War Memorial needs upgrade

30mph Speed Display – has now been moved to Station Road

Reed Court Re vehicle abandoned in Reed Court – HC will put a 5 day notice on it and then have it removed.

Village Hall finances Quote for plastering hall now received - Village hall will now submit funding request to CC

Riverside path: Path now almost complete – COAT have asked if we could have an official opening – **CC to discuss**

Porridge Linda Jolly asked that the minutes from 25<sup>th</sup> February be amended to say that both Mary’s meals and Maggie’s Highlands had sent in thank you letters for donations received. Waiting to see what sponsorship is available for this years event – the miller who took part in the Porridge 09 has invited Ian Bishop and Linda to Sunne, Sweden in May.

Overtaking between Carr-bridge Hotel and end of speed limit - this has been reported to the Chief Inspector – they will see if it can be done within regulations.
