## Minutes of Meeting on Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> September 2010 in the Village Hall

### Concerns of Village Residents

Colin Rostant - Noticed Strathy article on proposal to reduce street lighting at night and wondered if this would include Carr-Bridge? Probably would happen everywhere if it goes ahead. Also has concerns re speeding on the Inverness Road in Carr-Bridge. Has found out through the Freedom of Information Act that there are no plans to introduce new traffic calming measures in the near future. The police have suggested the CC approach local hotels and ask them to speak to their coach drivers re watching their speed within the village. Also some signs on the Inverness Road are becoming obstructed by bushes – could they be cut back? **SB** to speak to **SBlack**

Alex and Craig Wilding wondered if there was a public right of way from river walk across Donald's? Thought not.

Ranald McWilliam – Wondered if the CC would support the formation of a bike jump park in the area of waste ground down from the bowling green? Agreed in favour in principle. Ranald will put together a written proposal to bring to next meeting. LC pointed out the Gathering Committee have been discussing possibility of extending carving arena into the same area. Would be good if there would be enough space to allow for both projects.

**Access Around Carr-Bridge and Leaflet** Decided to probably drop Golf Course walk as some of the route is not very accessible. The CC are happy to let sub group go ahead and make decisions re naming routes etc.

**Minutes of Meeting 26<sup>th</sup> August 2010** Have been displayed in Post Office. Proposed as correct by FM, seconded by DR. Agreed unanimously

Shed for CC Matt Johnston is trying to get HC view of the project. Will then apply for planning permission. If/when granted will then decide on a shed and install.

Trains stopping at Carr-Bridge Station Still unclear which platform trains will stop at, Some people even wait on the bridge. Agreed to write letter to Scotrail. **SB**

**Treasurer's report** Accounts have been circulated. Final Duck Race income minus all expenses £1269.62. Letter of thanks has been received from Cancer Research for £100 donation. Gathering income to date just over £9,000 –still some bills to pay. Approx £35,000 between CC and Carr-Bridge Ahead accounts – a lot to be holding on to but we do have expensive projects planned – Upgrading Play Park and Village Hall and CC Shed.
