### Concerns of Village Residents

Kate Clark noted that Repairs on road at Kinveachy have been done, but in the same way as before, so that problem will recur. **SBlack** had asked Trunk Roads people to make better improvement, but they said they would do this and do proper drainage – and then they do not do it. He will speak to them again

### Access Around Carr-Bridge and Leaflet

Adam has sent email with details of design and sites of Signposts and Waymarkers. These would be dark green in colour to fit with Rights of Way notices and with the environment. Still looking at interpretation and leaflet.

KA has had email and telephone call from Sonia Wayman, Projects Officer, Planning & Development Service, HC. They are working on signage for Ellanwood, and have funding to contribute. They are also looking at interpretation, and would like to incorporate a chain saw carving of a wood ant done by Ian Chalmers. General approval of this idea. **KA** to reply to Sonia, and also ask that she contacts the Steering Group to discuss interpretation

**Minutes of Meeting 28<sup>th</sup> October 2010** Have been displayed in Post Office. One alteration suggested by CW, so para about Website was amended as follows: CW said that Roy Brown still does the email and he feels it has rather dated technology which is difficult to update. Could have focus on what groups of people want – either local or visitors. CCC own website and P/W is CCC's. If we want update we must ask for potential web masters to submit tenders. Working group of SB, CN and CW will look at best way forward (*This paragraph is amendment from Minutes displayed in Post Office*) Minutes proposed as correct by SB. Agreed unanimously
