Matters Arising

Marquees Outstanding have arrived. DR pointed out that need a Certificate of Competency to erect them – and he cannot have this for big marquees. Would be up to Dougie and Ian Grant

Insurance on marquees Would be £113 per annum on value £5,500. They would only be covered if in our control. Other operators would have to insure them separately for each event. We need a check procedure that this is done before marquees are allowed out

Grants for marquees Have to show public recognition of funders' contributions before grant can be paid. To go in newsletter. Final report cannot be sent until this has been done. Was grant due from CNPA (LC) or Awards for All (LJ)? We really need this info from LC – probably CNPA last year and Lottery this year

Buses going thro' village SBlack contacted David Summers. Problem over monopolies Commission and merger of Stagecoach delaying the sorting of this

Heather Hopper is doing well at present. SBlack to ask for more advertising on bus shelters and more brochures for hotels, Lochanhully etc.

Speeding on Station Road Item in newsletter. P.C. Ross Polworth agreed to look at it

Riverside Walk Bad state. Volunteers used to maintain it. Has CN spoken to Fran Potheary about CNP money. Also Donald Powell's bank needs attention – SB to speak to him
