Toilets Richard Porteous from HC says we are keeping the temporary toilets for summer. Great concern about smell of sewerage from Main toilets. **Bill Lobban** to take this health & Safety issue to HC and Scottish Water

Matters Arising

Tulloch housing development no progress

Windfarm and Community Benefit As there is still no Planning decision from the Reporter at Scottish Executive, no meeting was held with Fiona Milligan from Windfarm developers

Village traffic calming AK met sub-group, who want CCC to buy 2 flashing signs for the Inverness Road, and also put one on Grantown road and one by Landmark; and they also want rumble strips. There are questions about the cost to TEC Services of installation and maintenance.

Also noted that roads had been top-dressed, but red surfaces not improved – Bill Lobban said this was not in the Budget, and the white lining would be done when they are in the area. **Bill** will take these points to Highland Council (HC)

Any Other Business

Trees at Bridge are overhanging the Path and are unsafe. Formal report is needed

Jeannie Munro From Save our Dava has asked for our support on the Inner Moray Firth development Plan. Although this is not in our area it is about Lochindorb and surrounds. Currently this is a Special Landscape Area designation, but Plan suggests removing this designation. Agreed that Lochindorb is important to our visitors and we would not like it to change. LC to write with our opposition to removal of the Designation
