Matters Arising

<u>Village Hall</u> AK invited all those present to contribute to the discussion but to talk through the chair and observe protocols. IC said that the access was no in the hands of Scottish Heritage. Mairi Murray had accessed the hall successfully on her own in a wheelchair. The VH do the best in the circumstances. Old building covered by restrictions on change. Cllr Lobban said that HC wanted to keep the VH as official polling station and consider it a derogatory step to move to school. Decision by HC by end March. AK said that the CC would consider helping financially if required. AR asked if there would be two handrails and was told yes. Disabled access was OK 2 months ago. JC We had to do ramp at doorway and tried to do the best. Ramp is for parents with pushchairs. Disabled access is from parking area. AK asked if CC could be kept informed.

<u>Baddengorm Bridge Closure</u> – Feb 26 to March 16. Problems with buses to Inverness. At least 7 people are affected travelling to Millburn School, College and work. Simplest solution would be to do a deal with <u>Scotrail</u>. IM suggested contacting the local transport company (BSCTC) for help. Could HC subsidise difference in rail and bus fares? Cllr Lobban will contact transport co Friday. AK will liaise <u>DR Bridge</u> is not lit up yet.

<u>JC Signs on road insufficient</u>. Could there be another in a more prominent position. DMcL Also badly signposted coming from Inverness at Blackmount. Cllr Lobban to speak to HC & Bear

<u>Service Point Closure</u> - Suggested that we all go online but not everyone has access. Has still to go to a full HC meeting. CC to email Chief Exec to object (AK).

<u>Fire & Rescue Consultation</u> – We discussed with D MacDonald & R Coltart and submitted a view on-line but not a good link

<u>Housing development</u> – Email from Sam Sweeney re our thoughts on suitability of access by Carr Road. Inspite of traffic calming measures the CC considers that Carr Road is unsuitable to service this development. Cllr Lobban took no part in this discussion.

<u>ACORP</u> - AK went to meeting in Pitlochry. About branch lines but in the north all are main line. Involving CCs in consultation. In group from Carrbridge to Dunkeld. Main priority is to protect our station. Change of franchise coming up.

<u>School Posters on Speeding</u> – LA said that 52 had gone to Lochanhully and others around the village + B&Bs Posters were shown to all. AK thanked LA for her work.

<u>Lottery registration</u>. - AK will do.

<u>Insurance</u> - Is bike park included. Park is through CBA. FMcM will phone Colin M to ask about payment. <u>Rosehill Residents.</u> – Letter received re track. Fwd to Village Hall.

<u>Electricity</u> – IC does HC negotiate rate for power. BL yes but if you can do better phone.
